This workshop will allow participants (particularly representatives from local governments, agencies, and Amtrak) to review public input from the “public workshop” as well as data obtained through the EDTM process and architecturally “test” the station location alternatives to determine a preferred station location for the City. The goal of the workshop will be to develop a draft conceptual plan for one or more station locations that identified appropriate locations for station infrastructure (station building, platform, parking), access, and related transit-oriented development. This workshop will be facilitated by TCRPC staff, and results will be presented back to the participants and the public in a subsequent public workshop (prior to formal presentation to the City Commission). No newspaper advertising will be run for this workshop.
