(Charter Sec. 51 & Code Sec. 2-201)

APPOINTMENTS BY CITY COMMISSION

BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT - Sec. 22-147(a) - 5 Members & 2 Alternates; Three-Year Terms. Compensation - \$10.00 per meeting attended. (Financial Disclosure required)

CONSTRUCTION BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT & APPEALS - Sec. 5-1.110; Four-Year Terms; Seven to Nine Members: 2 Division I Contractors, 1 Electrical Contractor, 1 Mechanical Contractor, 1 Plumbing Contractor; 1 Architect; 1 Engineer; and 2 Members of General Public. May be County resident. Also serves as "Housing Board of Adjustment & Appeals - Sec. 5-352. Designated as Board of Adjustment & Appeals for Standard Unsafe Building Abatement Code - Sec. 5-1.103.5 (Ord K-169). (Financial Disclosure required)

BOARD OF EXAMINERS OF CONTRACTORS - Sec. 5-19; Four-Year Terms; Two-Year Residence in County (except Director Ex-Officio); Ten Members. Dir of Bldg & Community Response and six licensed by State from any of these fields: Architect; Engineer; Swimming Pool, Roofing, or other Specialty Contractor; General, Residential, or Building Contractor; Electrical Contractor; Plumbing Contractor; or Mechanical or Air Conditioning Contractor. Section 489.131 - Three Consumer Representatives, resident of local jurisdiction. May not be or ever have been member or practitioner of a profession regulated by board. Compensation - \$20.00 per meeting attended payable quarterly.

CITY PLANNING BOARD - Sec. 2-221; Two-Year Terms; Two-Year Residence in City; 10 Members; Commissioners & City Manager, Ex Officio. Compensation - \$10.00 per month. (Financial Disclosure required)

CIVIL SERVICE APPEALS BOARD - Charter Article VII, Sec. 82; Two-Year Terms; Two Regular & Two Alternate Members; Must be sworn in. Compensation - \$5.00 per meeting attended. Resident of County. Qualifications: Sympathetic to civil service merit principle, cannot hold nor be a candidate for any public office or position, and shall not be a member of any local, state, or national committee of a political party or an officer in any partisan political club or organization. No person convicted of a crime involving moral turpitude. No officer or employee of city to hold office.

CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD - F.S. 162.05; Ord. No. H-152; Code Article XIII, Sec. 2-243; Seven Members; Three-Year Terms; Shall include, whenever possible: Architect, Businessman, Engineer, General Contractor, Sub-Contractor, Realtor. Must be City resident. Experience in fields of zoning & building control. Compensation - \$10.00 per month. (Financial Disclosure required)

SPECIAL MASTER - Sec. 2-253 (Ord. K-91); Two-Year Term; Must be an attorney and member of the Florida Bar; Presides over certain code enforcement matters.

FORT PIERCE UTILITIES AUTHORITY - Charter Article XII, Sec. 170; Four-Year Terms; Four Members appointed by City Commission; Mayor, Ex Officio; City Manager, Ex Officio without a vote. No member shall serve more than two consecutive terms. Must be qualified elector. No elected official, city employee, or business relationship with UA.

COMMUNITYWIDE COUNCIL - Citizen Participation Plan established by Res. No. 80-26; Amended by Res. No. 88-84; Amended by Res. No. 98-08; CRF 570.303 HUD; Housing & Community Development Act of 1987; Two-Year Terms; Eleven Members (recommended by Staff) - Four of low & moderate income from CDBG target area and five from community-at-large (odd numbered years) and two residents of federally assisted housing, representatives of community organizations or otherwise eligible for participation in the CDBG program (even numbered years); No member shall serve more than two consecutive terms.

POLICE OFFICERS RETIREMENT FUND BOARD OF TRUSTEES - F.S. 185.05; Code Sec. 13-161; Two-Year Terms; Two legal residents of City to be appointed by City Commission (plus two policemen appointed by policemen and one member chosen by majority of previous four, such person's name to be submitted to City Commission, who as a ministerial duty, shall appoint such fifth member). May succeed themselves. (Financial Disclosure required)

CITY TREE BOARD - Sec. 2-316 (Ord. I-357); Two-Year Terms; Five Members: Director of Public Works, Parks Supervisor, Urban Forester, and two City residents; No compensation.

ENTERPRISE ZONE DEVELOPMENT AGENCY - Ord. No. J-307 (Sec. 2-341); F.S. 290.0056; Four-Year Term; Governing body appoint 8 to 13 Commissioners; Membership shall consist of at least one representative from each of the following: Local Chamber of Commerce, local financial or insurance entity, the businesses operating within EZ, the residents residing within EZ, non-profit community based organization operating within EZ, the local Jobs & Education Partnership, the local code enforcement agency, and the local law enforcement agency. Governing body shall designate a chair and vice-chair.

HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD - Code Section 23-22 (Ord. K-72); Three-Year Terms; No fewer than Seven Members: To extent available, professional members of architecture, history, planning, archaeology, real estate, law, engineering, construction, etc. or lay members with experience in these fields. Must be City resident or operate business in City. (Financial Disclosure required.)

AFFORDABLE HOUSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE - Code Sec. 8.5-27 (Ord. J-48); Nine Members; One-Year Terms; Must be citizens; Shall include citizens actively engaged in: Residential building industry, banking or mortgage industry, representative of labor in home building, advocate for low-income persons, provider of affordable housing, real estate professional, and three citizens.

HOUSING AUTHORITY OF FORT PIERCE - F.S. Chapter 421.05; Five Members; Four-Year Terms. (One Resident or Low-Income Subsidy Member). (Financial Disclosure required).
