GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

General manual work in various ground/landscaping maintenance activities.

3. Performs preventive maintenance on various equipment.
4. Performs heavy manual labor such as: digging, lifting, spraying, etc.
5. May operate vehicles and wheeled, light equipment occasionally.
