Planning Board Minutes

OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE FORT PIERCE CITY PLANNING BOARD HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 14, 2006, IN FORT PIERCE CITY HALL, COMMISSION CHAMBERS, 100 NORTH US HIGHWAY 1, FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA.

Secretary Johnson called the meeting to order and called for Roll Call.

Secretary Johnson said unfortunately, that does not give us a quorum for this Planning Board meeting tonight. So, what we have to do at this point is unfortunately adjourn the meeting. But before I do that I have a couple of items to talk about. We have to talk about agenda Item number 8. I would like to make mention is Concurrency Management and Proportionate Fair Share Mitigation ordinance, which has also been scheduled as a back up for tomorrow night's meeting, which will be here, which will be a public hearing at 7:00 pm.
