



City of Fort Pierce Request to Intervene in a Quasi-Judicial Hearing

Pursuant to Resolution 19-R35, a **Party Intervenor** is a person with an interest in an application which is different than the public at large. Any person seeking to qualify as a party intervenor must submit a written request to intervene at least three (3) calendar days prior to the hearing for approval by the City Attorney. Such request shall include a detailed outline of his or her interest in the application, argument in favor or against it, copies of all exhibits which will be presented at the hearing, and names and addresses of all witnesses who will be called to testify (including resumes for any witness the person intends to qualify as an expert).
